Jack,

Thanks for your response. We think there might be some conflicting issues for this pad. We have submitted a request to rescind the air Plan Approval and return the gas production equipment to air exemption status now that the Waukesha generators are removed. Mr. David Balog received guidance from DEP Harrisburg on using this approach.

The shakedown period for the Plan Approval has ended and the Plan Approval will expire on 6/30/2025 unless converted to s State Only Operating Permit. However, as noted above, we agreed with Air Quality staff to return the gas production equipment to exemption status thereby alleviating the need for a SOOP. Once completed, we intend to install a microturbine under Exemption 31 to consume the gas produced.

To be clear the site currently has the ability to produce today due to the QNRGY unit that is plumbed to the wells, so technically the site isnt abandoned. We look forward to your response. Thanks!
